Colleges and universities report both aggregate loan debt and the number of graduates with debt who began their degree program at the reporting institution. Averages for institutional types, or sectors, represent total loan debt divided by number of students graduating with student loan debt from institutions in that sector. Debt is reported for student loans from all sources either certified by the institution or reported to the institution by the student or lending organization. In general, institutions have little information concerning alternative student loans. For this report, loan debt excludes Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS loans).
