\* Colleges and universities in Iowa report the number of graduates who began their degree program at the reporting institution, the number of such graduates with student loan debt, and their aggregate student loan debt. This report excludes transfer students and their student loan debt. Averages for institutional types, or sectors, represent total loan debt divided by number of students graduating with student loan debt from institutions in that sector. Debt is reported for student loans from all sources either certified by the institution or reported to the institution by the student or lending organization. For this report, loan debt excludes Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS loans).
