Directions:

- 1) Log into your account at www.ihaveaplaniowa.gov.
- 2) Select the Career Planning link from the top of the page.
- 3) Select the Learn About Yourself box and find the Work Values Sorter. You will need to complete the Work Values sorter assessment to complete this worksheet.
- 4) Next, choose the Explore Careers link. This link is found at the top of the screen and in the middle.
- 5) In the box titled Career Exploration Tools, select the Career Finder link.
- 6) From the Career Finder page, notice the list of characteristics on the left side of the page. Choose the Work Values characteristic.
- 7) On the next page, look to the top right of the screen and click on the text, "Use work values survey results." This will insert your results from your most recent Work Values assessment. Then, scroll to the bottom of the page and select the see your matching careers link.
- 8) How many careers are a good fit for your current work values?

- 9) How many careers listed would require you to earn a high school diploma to perform the career's duties? **Answer will vary by student.**
- 10) How many careers listed would require you to earn an Associate's degree? **Answer will vary by student.**



11) How many careers listed would require you to earn a Bachelor's degree? **Answer will vary by student.**

12) How many careers listed would require you to earn more than a Bachelor's degree? **Answer will vary by student.**
